# Flight Test standards for all licenses to be taught

- Examine contents and sample of some air exercises.

# How to perform a pre-flight test (Private and Commercial)

- Use the actual examiners form-see online example
- Be proficient at the Flight Test Guide, know what examiner is looking for.
- Know the standards.
- Apply the 4 point marking scale.
- Do not accept excuses, grade objectively.
- Be impartial and not allow your previous interactions with the student to cloud judgment and evaluation.
