

# Instructor Training Air Instruction Demonstration/Performance Method

## Stage 1

### **Explanation - Class 1**

Briefly question instructor trainee as to how the exercise should be taught. Ensure focus is on how to teach exercise, not how to do it. Use FIG - Air instruction for guidance

### **Demonstration - Class 1**

Demonstration of how to teach exercise. (Trainee may assume role of student pilot during demonstration).

### **Student Performance - Instructor Trainee**

Trainee practices Explanation/Demonstration portion. (Class I assumes role of student pilot)

### **Instructor Supervision - Class 1**

Class I must supervise instructor trainee performance while assuming role of student pilot.

### **Evaluation - Class 1**

Class 1 tests instructor trainee as required to ensure lesson objectives met.

## Stage 2

*Instructor Trainee assumes role of instructor. Class 1 assumes roles of student pilot.*

### **Explanation - Instructor Trainee**

Briefly explains the how to of the exercise prior to demonstrating. Possibly asks a few procedural questions.

### **Demonstration - Instructor Trainee**

Demonstrates air exercise, explaining as required. Assigns student practice.

### **Student Performance - Class 1**

Class 1 assumes role of student pilot, performs the exercise. Makes errors

### **Instructor Supervision - Instructor Trainee**

Instructor Trainee supervises student performance.

### **Evaluation - Instructor Trainee**

Instructor trainee conducts fault analysis on student pilot performance.  
Tests student pilot as required on ability to meet the lesson goals.

## Stage 3

Class 1 conducts evaluation of overall lesson
