Prerequisites

1. Commercial Pilots License Issued
2. Valid Class 1 Medical
3. 20 Hours Instrument Time
 1. 10 Hours Instrument Flight Time
4. Complete 25 Hours Ground School
5. Complete 30 Hours Flight Training
 1. 5 hours training on teaching instrument flight skills
6. 70% Pass on AIRAF Exam
7. Must have completed the CPAER before Instructor Ground School training can begin.

Instructor classes & privileges

1. Class 4 – Flight Instructor Under Supervision
2. Class 3
3. Class 2
4. Class 1

Class 4

1. Must be employed at a licensed flight school.
2. Conduct training towards a pilot license, endorsement or rating.
3. Authorize a solo flight.
4. Recommend a trainee for flight test for pilots license.
5. Recommend a training for a night rating endorsement.

Valid: 1 year (1st of 13th month)

Under direct supervision of Class 1 or 2 with progress checks

1. At least once before first solo
2. Once before flight test.

Class 3

1. All Class 4 privileges.
2. Instruct without direct supervision.
3. Authorize first solo or cross-country flights.
4. Act as CFI for a flight school where there are no other flight instructors.
5. Valid 2 years (1st of 25th month)
6. Recommend 3 first solos & 3 students for flight test
 1. Must conduct 50% of the last 10 hours for each.

Class 2

1. All Class 4 & 3 privileges.
2. CFI for a flight school.
3. Valid 3 years (1st of 37th month)
4. Provide direct supervision to class 4.
5. 70% pass in AIRAT
6. Complete Class 2 flight test
7. Minimum 500 hours flight instructor experience.
8. No less than 10 recommends

Class 1

1. All Class 4 & 3 & 2 privileges.
2. Conduct ground school instruction towards flight instructor rating
3. Valid 4 years (1st of 49th month)
4. 80% pass in AIRAT
5. Complete Class 1 flight test
6. Minimum 750 hours flight instructor experience.
7. No less than 10 recommends

Instructor requirements

Must have been issued with CPL.

Complete 30 Hours flight training.

Complete 25 Hours ground training.

Exam: AIRAF (70%)

Flight Test: Transport Canada Examiner

RPP – Recreational Pilot Permit

1. More Restrictive License
2. Day VFR Only
3. PIC of:
 1. Single Engine
 2. Maximum of 4 seats
 3. Only 1 passenger carried.
4. Age: 16
5. Medical: Cat 4
6. Training: 25 Hours
 1. Dual: 15 Solo: 5
 2. 2 Hours Cross Country Training

PPL – Private pilots license

Can act as PIC or co-pilot of a plane in the class and type for which the license is issued.

Medical : Category 3

Exam: PPAER (60%)

Training: 45 Hours (17 Dual, 12 Solo)

3 Hours X/C Training

5 Hours X/C Solo (+150 NM)

CPL – commercial Pilots License

Can exercise the privileges of PPL, VFR OTT and while providing a commercial service.

Medical : Category 1

Exam: Air Law, Navigation, Met, General Knowledge (60%)

Training: 35 Dual, 30 Solo

5 Hours Solo Night

300NM

Total: 200 Hours (100 Solo)

Night Rating

Total of 20 hours required as follows:

10 Hours night flight time

- ▣ 5 hours dual
- ▣ 5 hours solo (including 10 take offs and landings)

10 Hours dual instrument time.

Type Ratings-two crew

PPL or CPL: 70% Type Rating-Aeroplane (IATRA) exam

OR: 70% SAMRA and SARON within 24 months

OR: ATP(A) Exams within 5 years

OR: ATPL

250 hours aeroplane

flight training on type

PPC on type last 12 months

High Performance Type Rating

$V_{ne} > 250$ kts or $V_{so} > 80$ kts

Ground & flight training

200 hours

qualifying flight

Trainer: CPL/ATPL 50 hours on class, 10 on type
